- 1) take your own photographs
- 2) work with scent + oils in your book
- 3) create a special pen, writing wand or quill
- 4) use printables
- 5) write entries in a magickal alphabet
- 6) create black out or found poetry
- 7) glue broken jewelry or charms on the cover
- 8) use recycled wrapping paper to line your book



- 9) include fabric that has a history
- 10) play with different *kinds* of paper
- 11) write recipe cards
- 12) use a stencil on the cover or page corners
- 13) Add coloring pages
- 14) use brads to attach cards, leaves, ribbon or notes
- 15) drip candle wax on the cover
- 16) decoupage fabric on the outer or inner cover
